- Notifications of acceptance/rejection will go out electronically by August 3, 2015
- Concurrent sessions are 75 minutes long
- Selections will be based on the following criteria:
 - Relevance to the topics of behavioral intervention, mental health, violence prevention, threat assessment, model programs, and case management
 - Completeness, detail and professionalism of the proposal
 - Evidence-based, promising and innovative model programs/practices are welcome
 - Engaging format, presenters and/or concepts
- You are encouraged to submit multiple proposals
- Co-presented sessions are encouraged
- All concurrent session presenters must register and pay for the conference. There are no waived or reduced registration fees for presenters.
- You need not be a NaBITA member to attend, nor to present.
- All presenters selected must be physically present for their sessions (telepresence not permitted).
- Please note that, in order to provide a variety of topics during each session, NaBITA reserves the right to assign date and time of each presentation session. Changes to the schedule cannot be accommodated.
